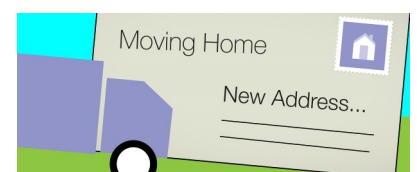
### **Planning 2018**

# COMMUNITY ANNOUNCEMENTS



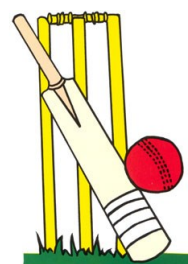
