Crazy Hair Day

On Friday 23rd November we held a special awareness day for our beautiful student Rani who has Alopecia Areata. Students and teachers learnt that the word "alopecia" means hair loss. Alopecia Areata is an auto-immune condition that results in hair loss on the scalp and elsewhere on the body. It can range from small, individual smooth patches of hair loss, to total loss of all hair on the body - including ear and nose hair. Alopecia Areata is not uncommon, and current estimates suggest that 2% of the population will be affected by the condition at some point in their lifetime. It can affect people of all ages, genders and ethnicity, but most commonly presents during childhood. We raised \$171.50 which will go to the Australia Alopecia Areata Foundation to assist in improving the lives of people living with Alopecia Areata.
