I was really proud of the input from our students as they worked with other students to brainstorm what schools, parents and students can do to reduce bullying. This is certainly addressed with a zero tolerance approach at Bramfield Park and staff are constantly talking to our students about reporting incidents of bullying and what they can do to reduce or stop bullying behaviour. The Minister of Education will use feedback from the Forum to provide a resource for all schools to assist in addressing incidents of bullying and cyber bullying.

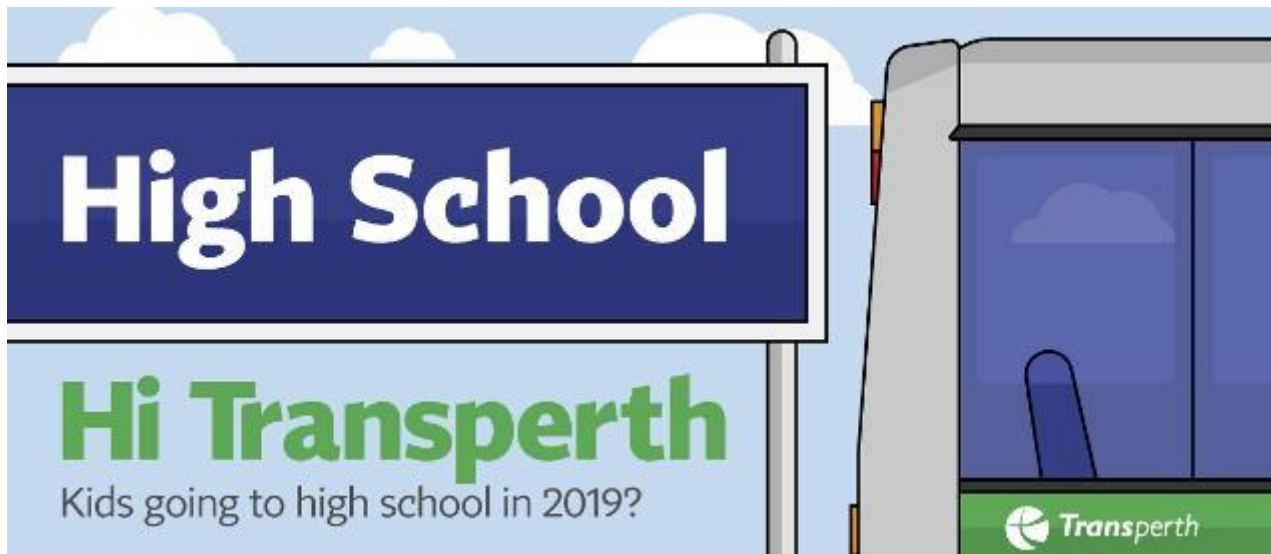
