

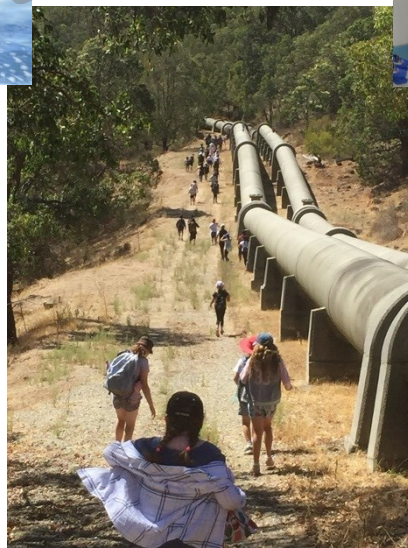

Year 5/6 Camp and Camp Assembly

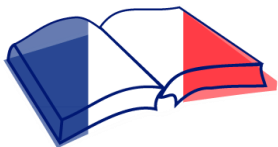

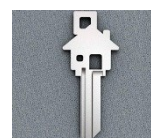

Flourless Chocolate, Orange and Beetroot Cake

- 6 Eggs
- ¼ cup Dark Brown Sugar
- 2 cups Ground Almonds
- 2 tsp Baking Powder
- 1 Orange Zest from 1 Orange
- ½ cup Freshly Squeezed Orange Juice
- 4 tbsp Dutch Cocoa Powder
- 170 g Beetroot, peeled and cooked



1. Cook chopped beetroot in a pot of boiling water until tender.
2. Remove cooked beetroot from pot and let s.t.
3. In a food processor add dry ingredients and blend until it well mixed.
4. Add cooked beetroot (drained), orange zest and juice and mix.
5. Add eggs, two at a time and blend between adding each two. Scrape down edges of bowl if necessary. The mixture should be quite runny and not as thick as standard cake mixture.
6. Place in an oiled and lined, spring form cake tin.
7. Bake in a moderate oven for 40 minutes or until cooked all the way through.
8. Cool for 5 minutes in tin before removing and placing on a cake rack to cool. You may need to separate the cake from the edge of the tin with a spatula before removing.
