Dear families,

Welcome to the new school year. We are all looking forward to a positive and successful year at Bramfield Park Primary School and staff will continue to build relationships with our families to ensure the best possible learning outcomes for all of our students.

### Staffing

There have been a few staffing changes for 2020. I would like to welcome Mrs Rebecca Viner who won the permanent Deputy Principal position advertised last year. Mrs Viner has visited most classes to meet our students and has had an enjoyable first few weeks at our school. Mrs Dye will be our French Specialist Teacher working on Thursday and Friday in the Art Room. All classes have had one lesson and the Art Room is looking great already with the addition of some French resources. Mr Wong will be sharing the Year 4/5 class with Mr Herbert, being the class teacher on Thursday and Friday while Mr Herbert continues in his role as STEM coordinator and takes some long service leave. We also have a friendly new School Officer Ms Claybrook who will happily help you out with any queries in the front office.

### Break times

This year we have introduced new times for our recess and lunch breaks. Lunch will now be at 11.00 am to 11.40 am and recess will be from 1.40 pm to 2.00 pm. We found that some students were very hungry before the first break last year so we thought a more substantial meal earlier would help with learning and spending 40 minutes outside at 11.00 am is better than at 1.00 pm, as was the case last year.
